RAMPART REMINDERS

As everyone continues to re-educate RAMPART paramedics, please ensure that the training emphasizes these very important points:

1. Proper use of the RAMPART Length-based Weight Estimation tape: completely unfold the tape prior to use, so that one can see **both** ends.
2. One end of the tape says "MEASURE FROM THIS END" with the word "HEAD" and an arrow. Measure from that end.
3. EVERY child must be measured using this tape before they can be considered eligible for enrollment in RAMPART.
4. Only children measuring into the **PURPLE** or **WHITE** areas of the tape are eligible for enrollment.
5. Children measuring in the **RED** area should **NEVER** be enrolled.

Bonus Hint: Infants under 1 yr old will **ALWAYS** be in the **RED** area.
DO NOT ENROLL A BABY.
