WebDCU: Down March 3rd, 2p-10p EST

The MUSC Data Center which contains WebDCU servers will be powered down on Saturday, March 3rd, beginning at 2:00p Eastern. All services are planned to be fully restored by 10p Eastern the same day, but may be restored prior to that time. **During this period, WebDCU may be unavailable for randomization and data entry.**

To randomize a subject during this time, please first check to see if WebDCU is available. If WebDCU is not available, refer to the emergency randomization procedures outlined in the study's Manual of Procedures.

POINT: Congratulations! Overall POINT enrollment has passed the 700 subject mark, with 366 of those subjects from the NETT sites! Thank you.

Please continue to remind study staff to carefully review the MAR to avoid concomitant use of prohibited and discouraged medications while on study drug.
