SHINE **Screen fail logs:** There are a substantial number of screen fails entered into WebDCU that should not be included. Please report only those patients who present to your hospital with an ischemic stroke, within 12-hours of symptom onset (or last time seen well) with a blood glucose level >110. Please DO NOT include intracranial hemorrhages or any patients whose blood glucose is 110 or less. DO NOT report hemorrhagic strokes.

Recruitment: As required by the Data Safety Monitoring Board, we are reviewing expected vs. actual enrollment reports for all SHINE sites. On a quarterly basis, all SHINE Hubs and Ancillary sites are provided with a site-specific recruitment report, detailing enrollment and outlining any procedures and/or additional training needed. We are rolling out the first reports in early February 2013.
