## WebDCU: **Randomization Emergency Hotline (1-866-450-2016)**

The new Randomization Emergency Hotline has been established for SHINE, POINT and ProTECT **emergency randomization issues** ONLY. Please use this number if you encounter problems trying to randomize in WebDCU or if there is a problem with the randomization assignment generated by WebDCU. Some examples include: a study bottle/kit number does not match any of the bottles/kits in your pharmacy, the WebDCU system is down, or you cannot figure out how to generate the randomization number after reading through the randomization instructions posted on the study's main menu page.
