## RAMPART

### Study Box Updates

The updated RAMPART Study Box User Manual is posted on the RAMPART website under MOP (<https://rampart.umich.edu/rampart/mop>). Click on Section 23.

#### Some new items of interest are:

- ◆ Version 2.0 displays "Ready to use" after use (during an enrollment) rather than "finished".

- ◆ Other status flags displayed on the screen have changed. Please see *Basic System Functionality* in the User Manual.

- ◆ Helpful tip sheets for three versions of the study box program (including the most recent, version 2.0) can be found at the end of the User Manual. Please keep these handy as you use the study boxes.

**Continue to use care when handling the study boxes to avoid damage. In particular, please use care when inserting the batteries:**

- ◆ Give both RED and BLACK wires some slack (push carefully towards the connection point) before inserting quarters and batteries.

- ◆ When setting the box always insert quarters *before* batteries - this protects the wire connections.

- ◆ Use only the BLACK wire compartment to insert the battery when there is a need to obtain information from the box (e.g., to get the study box ID #) rather than the RED wire compartment.
